## The Boulevard Streetscape Revitalisation

We're writing to update you on the initial stages of The Boulevard Streetscape Revitalisation Project. A contract was awarded to Evergreen Civil Pty Ltd and works commenced earlier this month.

We're pleased to report that the works have commenced and are progressing in line with the project timeline.

### Completed construction activities:

- Site compound establishment
- Fencing of the Stage 1A of the construction area on the west side of the Station Street
- Underground services location and tracing
- Installation of site signage and Variable Message Sign (VMS) boards
- Implementation of the Traffic Management Plan
- Demolition of the footpath, kerb and channel on the west side of Station Street
- Removal of asphalt pavement on the west side of Station Street.

Construction activities have been carefully staged to minimise impacts to pedestrian pathways and parking areas. Works began in early February 2026 and are expected to continue until late 2026, subject to weather and site conditions.

The current focus is on Station Street, where works include new tree and garden bed plantings, upgraded lighting, safer on street parking, traffic calming measures, raised pedestrian crossings, relocated bins, and a new shared user path with improved bike lanes.

<b>Planned construction activities to be completed in the next few weeks</b>	
Stage 1A – West side of Station Street <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Preparation and concrete works for the new kerb and channel</li> <li>• Preparation and concrete works for the shared user path</li> <li>• Demolition of existing road pavement</li> <li>• Construction of road pavement on the west side of Station Street</li> </ul>	
<b>Construction noise</b>	Higher than normal noise levels and some localised dust may occur during earthworks. Evergreen Civil Pty Ltd will manage dust and adjust activities where required.
<b>Site access</b>	Construction vehicles access the site via the Station Street car park.
<b>Upcoming traffic changes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Major works will include road pavement reconstruction on Station Street</li> <li>• The western footpath on Station Street will remain closed until further notice</li> <li>• The western side of Station Street will be closed from 18 February to 6 March</li> <li>• Southbound to northbound traffic will be detoured via Cedar Street</li> </ul> Vehicles travelling from The Boulevard toward the northern end of Station Street will be detoured via Currajong Street and Fir Street

Public Transport Victoria (PTV) and Dyson Bus Lines will temporarily divert Route 570 along Cedar Street and Beech Street. To support this diversion, on-street parking on both streets will be temporarily restricted.

Northbound to southbound traffic on Station Street will remain unchanged during construction.

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We appreciate your patience and cooperation during these works and will continue to minimise disruption wherever possible.

**Access to shops and pedestrian pathways will remain a priority and will be maintained during regular business hours.**

## The Boulevard streetscape revitalisation



- 1 Additional 1m of footpath trading space in front of southern-facing shops with bollards, garden beds and seating arrangements to provide amenity and maximise vehicle exclusion.
- 2 New gathering spaces and seating areas with shade trees.
- 3 Additional street trees along The Boulevard with permeable paving, structural soil and improved drainage.
- 4 Twenty-six standard car parking spots in front of the shops along The Boulevard. (No loss of existing parking spots).
- 5 New pedestrian and cyclist raised platforms/crossings.
- 6 Feature public lighting.
- 7 Removing underutilised left turning lane from south of The Boulevard to offer wider footpaths on both sides of the street.
- 8 New turning radiuses to improve safety and expanded public realm.
- 9 New shared user path along Station Street and south side of The Boulevard.
