#### When is a permit required?

Are you looking to provide outdoor dining, footpath trading, install signage or make structural alterations to your shop premises?

#### **Keeping retail areas clean**

Do you have a council rubbish or recycling bin for your business?

Things you should know about your Council bin

- Council bins must be kept in clean condition in an area within the premises when not being left out for collection
- Council bins can be left out for collection after 4pm the day before collection and must be removed the same day as collection
- Business owners must only place rubbish in the council rubbish bin that has been generated at the business
- Business owners must only place recyclable items in the council recycling bin – you can check what is allowed to be placed in the recycling bin on council's website.
- Place empty recyclable items loosely in your recycling bin and do not place recycling in plastic bags
- Do not place items that are dangerous, flammable, explosive or hazardous into bins including batteries and gas bottles
- Do not put anything in the bin that prevents the lid closing
- Your bin must not weigh more than 50kg when collected.

Please contact council for assistance in reducing and disposing of waste, recyclable materials, and other items in a responsible manner.
